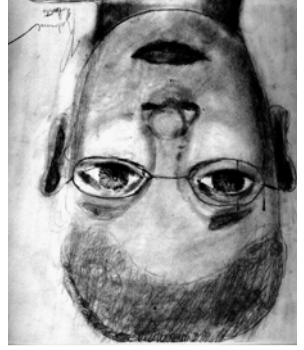


2006 Annual Report

Encouraging Indianapolis Youth Through Success in Art

The Program

Art with a Heart currently offers summer camps, after school programs, and kindergarten and Saturday Honors programs during the school year.

Instruction Offers:

- Yearly math-based after-school programs
- Themed art week-long summer camps (sports, fashion design, pets, Harlem Renaissance, etc)
- Daring to Draw and Primary Process for once-a-week summer instruction at collaborator's site
- Drawing, painting, collage, sculpture, printmaking, weaving, and mosaic included in programs
- Lesson plans that include State Standards
- A major emphasis on the children's ability to maintain focus and learn skill and technique
- Creation of murals and art installations



In 2006, AWAH served 1,078 children and teenagers with art classes and an additional 1,725 individuals with art exhibitions. Most of our children live in poverty and reside in high-risk environments. Typically about 50% of AWAH students are from single parent families and 61% are from families below the federal poverty level. The diverse population served in 2006 was as follows: 63 % Black/African American, 15% Hispanic, 17 % Caucasian, 3% Multiracial and 2%Other.

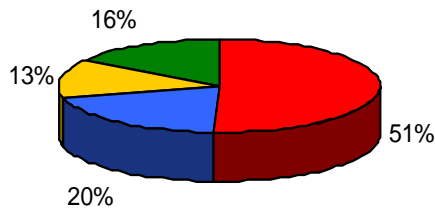

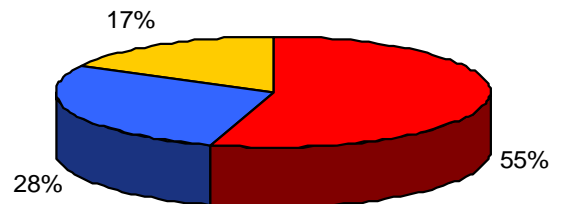
2006 Income
